Profile: People in downtown malls and indoor walkways

Downtown Winnipeg's 2 kilometres of indoor walkways connect The Bay to Portage & Main and beyond, providing a year-round climate-controlled system that keeps downtown pedestrians warm and dry.

- Access to over 1.8 million square feet of space
- Over 200 shops and businesses
- 10 office complexes
- 60 restaurants and snack bars
- 700 apartment units
- 2 hotels
- 11 financial centres
- The MTS Centre and Millennium Library
- The Bay and YMCA-YWCA
- Connects 21,000 downtown employees
- Connecting to 3,733 parking stalls

FUTURE OPPORTUNITY: Watch for the walkway completion, connecting the loop from The Bay to St. Mary Avenue, to the Winnipeg Convention Centre, to cityplace.
